

IMPORTANT ROUND ROBIN INFORMATION

ROUND ROBIN RULES:

70-minute drop dead.

NFHS book rules, with the following exceptions:

- Free substitution, continuous line-up allowed.
- Courtesy runner for pitcher, catcher (any player may be used).
- There is no penalty for subbing for an injured player or a player that must leave early or comes late. Goal is to get kids on the field.
- Run rules; 12 run lead after 3 innings, 10 run lead after 4 innings, 8 run lead after 5 innings.

Coin toss will determine the home team

Each team must provide game balls to be used while on defense. Softballs must be optic yellow leather, 0.47 COR, MAX 375 compression and "good for tournament play". It will be in the umpire's decision to determine softball playability.

All home run balls should be awarded to the player.

PRE-GAME WARMUPS:

Our field maintenance volunteers work extremely hard at getting the fields ready for play. Therefore, we respectfully ask that no pre-game warm-ups take place on the infield while it is being dragged. Teams may warm up in the outfield grass beyond the outfield fencing. Please have all players ready 15 minutes before the scheduled game time to ensure that this event runs smoothly.

WEATHER:

In the event of inclement weather, please do not leave the facility until the site director gives direction. The umpire may delay the game, but the tournament staff will determine whether there will still be play or whether we are cancelling for all or part of the day. Weather updates will be available through the Stateline Sports Group App.

CONCESSIONS:

We hope you will support the concessions. There will be a variety of food items and drinks for purchase on site. Please no coolers or cook-outs.

COMPLEX RULES:

- No Coolers (one team cooler allowed)
- No Sunflower Seeds or Gum
- No Outside Food or Drink
- No Smoking or Tobacco Products
- No Firearms permitted

COVID-19 GUIDELINES:

As everyone knows the state of Illinois is still under the Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines requiring event mitigations. We ask your cooperation by following the facility rules during the event.

- Face coverings must be worn by all spectators when moving about the park.

- We ask for all fans to bring chairs and sit in family pods.
- We ask all fans using the bleachers, to stay a minimum of 6 feet from non-family members.

GENERAL SPORTSMANSHIP:

As always, we are holding guests to the highest expectations of good behavior. General poor sportsmanship and/or verbal abuse of officials or opposing teams by coaches, players, or spectators will not be tolerated.

TOURNAMENT REFUND POLICY:

Inclement weather refunds as follows:

- No games played - full refund minus \$75 administration fee.
- One game played - 50% refund.
- Two games played constitutes a tournament with no refunds.
- If you have registered for multiple RR events, each event stands on its own for refunds.
- If you register for six or nine games in an event, refunds are prorated in multiples of three.

TEAM CANCELLATION POLICY:

Stateline Fury recognizes that there will be unforeseen circumstances that may require a team to withdraw.

- All cancellations prior to 10 days of tournament start date will be charged a \$75 processing fee.
- Cancellations made after the schedule is posted will not be refunded.
